## Event Details

**Hot Air Balloon Class:** Children will be making a mini hot air balloon to take home. Pre-registration is required and is limited to the first 15 children. Cost is \$5 per child, or \$4 for members of the Gardens. Call 637-6349 or come in to the Children's Village during open hours to register.

**JMG:** Junior Master Gardeners Program. This group will meet every Thursday at 4 pm. The program will run from March 4 through the end of August and is open to 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Cost is \$5 per child. Registration is required and is open to the first 20 students. The program this year will be working toward the Growing a Vegetable Garden certification and the students will be growing their own vegetables in a plot in the Cheyenne Botanic Gardens. ### **Family Learning Session: Seed Planting Basics and Starting Vegetables Indoors**

The Family Learning Sessions are classes on beginning vegetable gardening geared toward the entire family. This class will focus on starting seeds indoors and will explain which vegetables can/should be started indoors before the Cheyenne growing season starts. The session will be geared toward families with kids, but anyone who is interested is welcome to attend. Tickets are available in advance and registration is limited to the first 15 families. ### **Spring Break Survival Series: Primitive Techniques for Life and Survival in the Wild**

This program is a four day series for Junior High students and will serve as an introduction to life skills of the pre-historic and historic people of North America. Students will have the opportunity to create shelters, tools, containers, soap and more with materials found in nature, using Native American techniques. The sessions will run Tuesday, March 30<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> from 1 pm to 3 pm. The cost is \$10 per student, or \$9 for members of the Gardens.
