

PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

A PHOTO PERMIT AND RESERVATION ARE REQUIRED

Visitors to the Gardens who come with the primary intent of taking posed photographs inside the Grand Conservatory need to purchase a photo permit. This policy pertains to all photographers, whether they are professional, amateur, paid or unpaid.

Visitors that come to the Gardens with the primary intent to see and enjoy the Gardens that happen to take photos do NOT need a permit.

RESERVATIONS ARE BASED UPON AVAILABILITY

ALL PHOTOGRAPHERS:

Do not block sidewalks, move plants or furniture.

No climbing on the water feature. Monopods are permitted; tripods, lighting and props are NOT permitted.

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED TWO DAYS IN ADVANCE

PHOTO PERMIT RATES:

**Personal/Hobby/Class Photos:
No charge, no reservation required**

Groups from 1 to 3 people: \$10

Groups from 4 to 10 people: \$25

Groups from 11 to 20 people: \$45

Groups from 20 to 30 people: \$75

Yearly Permit: \$150/year

GROUPS THAT HAVE NOT RESERVED A PHOTO SHOOT:
if the space is available, may be charged a \$15 walk-in fee in addition to the above pricing.

PLEASE NOTE: The photography policy helps protect the plants and visitor experience of the Gardens. The policy allows the Gardens to lessen the disruptions of scheduled events. Fees support the Gardens' mission of connecting people with plants.
