



Cheyenne Botanic Gardens Volunteer Opportunities

Conservatory Horticulture: picking up plant debris, up-potting, sweeping, insect scouting, washing plants, and general cleanup.

Greenhouse Horticulture: seeding, taking cuttings, transplanting, watering, weeding, mixing soil, and general cleanup.

Outdoor Horticulture: planting, mulching, weeding, pruning, mowing, string trimming, raking, watering, emptying trash, and snow shoveling.

Children's Village Gardening: weeding, watering, dead heading, seed sowing, mulching, planting, sweeping, and other seasonal tasks. Teaching, reading, and assisting with classroom set up is also available.

Front Desk Greeter: greeting the public, providing information about events, programming, membership, volunteer opportunities and general information about the Cheyenne Botanic Gardens and Cheyenne.

Operations: winterizing buildings and water features, hardscaping, building repairs, minor construction projects, assisting with living wall and installing memorial plaques.

Community Gardening: planting, weeding, cleaning abandoned plots, turning compost, cleaning and organizing sheds, picking up trash and occasional watering.

Facilities Maintenance: window washing, sweeping, mopping, emptying trash, and general cleanup.

Grounds Maintenance: general repairs and maintenance to hardscapes (benches, structures, water features, out buildings).
